IPV6 GETTING UP-TO-SPEED

As commonly known, the IPv4 address-space is rapidly running out of IP-numbers, and many providers have to get prepared for IPv6 now. At NL-ix, and sister companies Open Peering (www.openpeering.nl) and JointTransit (www.jointtransit.nl), we happily notice that specially the last few months many customers start getting familiar with IPv6. From the current 215 members the following % are now using IPv6 :

- 28,7 % of the 'active peering members' are using the IPv6 peering LAN.
- 3,2 % of all members have ordered IPv6 address space via us.
- 7,9 % of all members have connected to the IPv6 Transit service (which is still free till end 2009).
- 10,2 % of all members have followed our IPv6 course (www.nl-ix.net/bgpcourse/bgpcourse.htm).

Expectations are that these figures may have doubled by the end of the year.
